



Oocyte Retrieval & Preservation Treatment costs

January 2025

At Coastal IVF all cycles are provided at a standard cycle fee without add-on costs.

When a cycle is planned, you will receive a written quote specific for your care- this lists all costs in advance and the quotation outlines the payment schedule before you commit to treatment.

Each treatment cycle will have an initial non-refundable establishment fee which covers the cost involved for cycle planning, pre-cycle consultation and ultrasound scan, and supply of medications. After payment of the establishment fee the cycle date will be confirmed, by the nursing staff, who will contact you to arrange an appointment time to collect your plan and medications.

Cycle Establishment Fee -(per cycle)	\$750.00
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If your cycle starts but is later cancelled, the establishment fee covers the planning, medication, management costs and visits/scans during the cancelled cycle. A cycle establishment fee will be required for your next cycle.

The table below provides you with a summary of the cycle fees and the expected Medicare and safety net rebates and your calculated final out of pocket costs for the cycle fee for treatment at Coastal IVF. For many women without a medical condition who elective freeze their eggs, Medicare does not provide a rebate, if you are unsure about your eligibility, please discuss this with your specialist.

Oocyte (egg) retrieval is typically performed in a hospital setting under general anesthesia (see next page for costs). In some cases, patients may be eligible for an in-rooms retrieval procedure using local anaesthesia. Please discuss with your clinician if you are interested in exploring your suitability for this option.

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The standard fees include (where necessary)- no extra out of pocket costs incurred:

- All medical and clinical procedures by an experienced clinician
- Scans/procedures and transfers provided (where indicated) 7 days a week
- Freezing of oocytes and initial 3- month short term storage period
- Psychology counselling is provided with our clinical psychologist for those patients undergoing IVF treatment who require additional support, please speak with our nurse coordinators for more information.
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All cycles are individualised, there are;

- No add on services and no unexpected clinical/embryology fees after the cycle
- No restrictions or limits to clinical/embryology services during ART cycles
- No cycle modifications that are not clinically appropriate to your care
- No nurse-only services

Oocyte retrieval

- Hospital Fees: For patients with health insurance, a fund excess may apply (check with your individual fund) Medicare item number 13212. For uninsured patients, oocyte retrieval is approximately \$1200.00- payable directly to the Sunshine Coast Day Surgery on admission,
- Anaesthetic Fees: Applicable to 'in hospital' procedures only, this fee will vary between anaesthetists and the duration of your procedure, a quote can be obtained from the Sunshine Coast Anaesthetic group- Tel: 07 5493 4383 Email: scag@sunshinecoastanaestheticgroup.com.au.

Non standard procedure costs

- Long term cryopreservation storage of oocytes. The storage program and payments are managed by Embryo Options on behalf of Coastal IVF. Annual storage fees are \$450.00- irrespective of numbers with options to pay annually or monthly. You will receive an email invitation from Embryo options to register approx. 2 months after completion of your cycle.
- Extra pharmaceutical costs- some medications require a private script and therefore you will be required to purchase these at the pharmacy. Routine ART medications during your cycle and luteal phase are provided by the clinic and are covered by the cycle establishment fee.
